Goals and Purpose for the Competition

1. Unite students from different backgrounds with one theme.
2. Celebrate Education Week with the students.
3. To attract student to the arts, increase their creativity, give them an opportunity to express themselves, and also have fun.
4. Increase visibility
5. Increase interactions between schools
6. Increase cross cultural communication
7. To commemorate Education week in a meaningful way
8. Group Building

International Language Schools Competition Areas

- Poster competition in any Language (ages 11-12-13)
- Arts and Crafts (ages 8 - 9 - 10)

Competition Structure

- A team of maximum 3 students for each category. i.e.
 - o For the poster competition
 - Identify 3 students in the age group 11 – 13 from the school.
 - Elect one of the students as group leader
 - Identify responsible instructor for group
 - o For Arts & Craft competition
 - Identify 3 students in the age group 8 – 10 from the school.
 - Elect one of the students as group leader
 - Identify responsible instructor for group
 - o Note: The same instructor could be responsible for both groups
 - o Note2: If you wish to compete in both categories fill out 2 registration forms

Theme

- The Theme for both categories will be the same.
- The theme will be presented on competition day
- The competition theme will be one of the following:
 - o “Languages for Peace”
 - o “Multiculturalism in Our Communities”
 - o Provincial Education Week 2004 theme
- The competition theme will be selected on competition day.

Poster Competition in Any Language:

- Paper size: double letter size
- Material: crayons

Arts and Crafts:

- On a card board use of waste material
- Waste material:
 - o left over pieces of scrap paper
 - o cardboard
 - o scotch tape
 - o masking tape
 - o crayons
 - o glue
 - o scissors
 - o old magazines
 - o newspapers
 - o egg cartons
 - o any stationary material you would normally throw away
- cardboard, scotch tape, masking tape, crayons, glue, scissors, scrap paper will be provided by the school board, competitors are responsible for bringing any other material they deem necessary themselves.

Competition Guidelines

- Competition and awards ceremony Saturday, May 8, 2004
- Competition registration deadline: Monday, May 3, 2004
- All schools must complete the online registration form at <http://www.turkishlanguage.ca/compregform.htm>
- Students to prepare content to compete
- All content to be prepared on competition day
- A school can choose to compete in either category or both.
- Material necessary for “Poster” category will be provided to students on competition day.
- Basic materials necessary for “Arts & Crafts” category will be provided to students and students are expected to bring their own waste materials (as listed above) to the competition.
- Competition to be 1 hour in duration, preceded by a half hour of instructions and introduction.
- Competition to be held during school hours, judging and awards ceremony right after.
- All work produced by students to be displayed at a location open to the public. Example location: shopping mall. This would increase our visibility.
- Teachers and students do not have to put aside extra time for the competition, other than competition day.
- Substitute instructor for each participating program will be financed by the board.
- The competition is to be held at Éducation permanente (CECLF), 181 Donald Street, Ottawa
- Certificate of participation will be given to all students competing
- Schools which have placed in the top 3 of each category will receive a award certificate
- Gold, silver, bronze medals will be awarded to every team member placed in the top 3 of each category
